



So, month after month, cancellation after cancellation, I would send an email to Joel (the gentleman who was coordinating the details of our vehicle), and apologize for yet another delay. Joel was patient, and really just wanted to minister to our family. Once we were fairly confident of our return at the

end of June, I reached out to Joel once more, and he let me know that there was a vehicle waiting for us. What a blessing to have that concern lifted off of our shoulders. Once more, thank you to those who have prayed about this need, as well as those who have already given toward it.

Now that we are back in the States, we have remained busy. We are trying to figure out the best way to continue ministering to Filipino pastors (even while we are away at present). We are hopeful to return to the Philippines at some point in 2021 (though we are unsure of the exact date). So, in the meantime, we are working on plans for some online courses to offer in order to continue helping equip and train national pastors in the Philippines.

Just a couple of weeks back we had the chance to visit one of our supporting churches at Twin City Bible Church in Nitro, West Virginia. What a great weekend to reconnect with this loving church family. We were greatly encouraged by their fervent love for the Lord (and for us). We actually made this a "weekend getaway" for Sarah and me. After leaving the kids with Grandmom and Pop Pop for some much needed time together, Sarah and I drove to West Virginia on Saturday, stayed in a beautiful hotel



Saturday night, got to spend the morning with the good folks at Twin City on Sunday morning, and then travelled back to Pennsylvania on Sunday afternoon. Although it was a short "getaway," it was the first night away we have had for over 2 years... and let me tell you 2 years is way too long!
