**TYPHOONS.** The Philippines has been hit with a barrage of Typhoons over the past few weeks that have enhanced the seasonal monsoon causing massive damage by high winds and torrential rain. The resource center on the Haven of Grace Seminary campus has been affected by these powerful storms as you can see from the images below. The cost of these repairs will be in the \$5,000-\$7,000 range. Our resource center is the heart of the seminary campus, and is used for our weekly classes, as well as for Summer Camps (in which we minister to over 3,000 Filipino teenagers each year).

A PRODUCTIVE SEASON. The period of the last two months has been one of the most productive seasons of my ministry at Haven of Grace Seminary. Here are some of the highlights: 1. I was able to compile 200+ pages of course notes for Romans (the class I am teaching this semester). 2. We set up an online seminary resource hub for our students where they are able to locate all of the materials needed for their classes (i.e. course notes / recorded lectures etc.), as well as to take their exams (online). 3. I sent out updated transcripts to all of our students, and have begun working with them to complete individual requirements needed to earn credits for those courses. This leads to our next point...
