

 - c. A memorable, life-changing trip (I am praying this trip will make a lasting impact on Jonas. It will afford us with some great one-on-one time, and I am really asking God to do a deep work in

Jonas' heart. I have been especially burdened for Jonas over the past year+, and I would simply ask you to pray for God to use this trip in Jonas' life).

SPRING CLASSES HAVE BEGUN. We had a great start to our Spring Semester. I am really grateful for the opportunity to work through the book of Romans with our students. There is nothing better than to dive deep in to the study of the gospel of Christ. In addition to our Filipino students, our class also included a few Bengali students. Pacific Rim Missions International is prayerfully considering the possiblity of establishing a seminary in Bangladesh, and these students are joining the class as a "test run" to see what the educational experience would be like.





UPCOMING VISIT FROM PASTOR JUN OGUILLA. At the end of this month we will be thrilled to welcome Pastor Jun Oguilla, and his wife, Juvy, to the United States. Pastor Jun is a dear friend and co-worker, who—in addition to his role as the pastor of Maranatha Baptist Church (Bacolod, Philippines)—also serves as the Vice President of the Haven of Grace Seminary Board. During his three-week stay Pastor Jun will be visiting the ARCH National Conference in Florida as well as preaching at a couple of churches, including our home church—Lighthouse Baptist (Newark, Delaware). We will have the privilege of hosting Pastor Jun and Ma'am Juvy in our home for a few days at the end of January and the beginning of February. It is a great joy to repay (in a small way) the hospitality this
